

Instructions

1. To qualify for a West Virginia Enhanced 9-1-1 Council license plate you must be actively employed as a telecommunicator in good standing with law enforcement, EMS, fire, or a 9-1-1 agency with the state of West Virginia and must return the license plate to the DMV when you are no longer actively employed as such.
2. The vehicle must be Class A, have a WV title, and WV license plate in the name of the applicant before a special plate can be issued.
3. The current license plate must be returned to the Division of Motor Vehicles after the special plate is received. After issuance of the special plate, the exchanged plate is canceled and cannot be transferred to another vehicle. There are no refunds.
4. Send the application and fees with a check or money order payable to the West Virginia Enhanced 9-1-1 Council, Inc. at the address listed below. Please include your personal property tax receipt or an affidavit from the assessor, if your registration is expiring within 60 days of your application.
