#### **GENERAL NOTES**

The West Virginia Turnpike Incident Management Emergency Traffic Control Plan identifies five permanently signed detour routes for use by the Parkways Authority and associated local agencies to provide alternative routes for the traveling public in the event of a road closure along the Turnpike. The traffic control requirements of each of these detours, A thru E, are provided within this manual.

The communications flowchart identifies the notifications and information flows that must occur to ensure proper implementation of the detour route.

Following the communications flowchart, a listing of contacts for critical members of the information sharing path is provided.


Guidance for implementing the traffic control elements for each detour is provided in the specific detour sections. Details are provided indicating the appropriate devices to be installed for facilitation of a roadway closure. Directives on locating portable changeable message signs and traffic directors are included in each detour's respective section.

#### TRAFFIC CONTROL FOR OPENING/USING MEDIAN BARRIER GATES OR MEDIAN CROSSOVERS

To facilitate the opening of the median barrier gate(s), a rolling roadblock shall be initiated in the opposite direction of travel from that of the backup. Additional rolling roadblocks will be required to allow the passing of vehicles thru the barrier gate. Parkways personnel must coordinate the initiation of the rolling roadblocks and passage of vehicles such that the process does not cause additional excessive backup in the opposite direction from the closed lanes.

Parkways staff shall employ two (2) or three (3) vehicles, as necessary, in tandem in one direction at a predetermined time and predetermined speed. Normally the speed shall be 35 mph or as directed by the Section Foreman. There shall absolutely be no stopping of the rolling roadblock. Prior to instituting such, the roadway ahead shall be cleared of traffic as directed by the engineer. The area of influence shall also be sealed off (all on-ramps or access intersections closed) by use of flaggers and/or Parkways vehicles and/or traffic directors as necessary. The rolling roadblock shall prevent any other vehicles from entering the defined area by making all vehicles proceed at a slower speed than normal and forcing all vehicles to follow behind the two (2) or three (3) vehicles at their predetermined speed. Under no circumstances shall any other safety and traffic control device be compromised, in fact, they may have to be adjusted to accommodate such.
