

2018 HIGH TRAVEL DAYS, EVENTS AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS
WHERE TRAVEL IS NOT ALLOWED

Memorial Day	Saturday, May 26, 2018 through Monday, May 28, 2018
Independence Day	Wednesday, July 4, 2018
Labor Day	Saturday, September 1, 2018 through Monday, September 3, 2018
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 22, 2018
Christmas Day	Tuesday, December 25, 2018
New Year's Day	Tuesday, January 1, 2019

Oversize loads are not allowed to travel from sunset to sunrise.

Event Restrictions – No Over dimensional travel between sunrise of the first date until sunset of the last date.

West Virginia University football games – No travel in Monongalia, Marion, Harrison and Preston Counties on the day of home games.

Pioneer Days Festival – No travel in Marlinton (Pocahontas County) on July 11 – 15, 2018 **

State Fair – No travel on US219 from I64 to Ronceverte (Greenbrier County) on August 9 – 18, 2018

Treasure Mountain Festival – No travel in Franklin (Pendleton County) on September 14 - 16, 2018 **

Forest Festival – No travel in Elkins (Randolph County) on September 29 - October 7, 2018 **

Bridge Day – No travel on US 19 between US 60 and Oak Hill (Fayette County) on October 20, 2018

Other Restrictions

School Bus Hours – No travel allowed Monday through Friday on two lane highways for escorted vehicles from 7 AM to 9 AM and 2:30 PM to 4:00 PM from August 10, 2017 through June 7, 2018.

Charleston Area – No travel allowed for escorted vehicles from 7 AM to 9 AM and 4 PM to 6 PM during daylight savings time.

During Eastern Standard Time, travel is allowed only from 9 AM to 4 PM. Charleston area includes I64 between Exit 39 and Exit 85, I77 between Exit 106 and Exit 85, US119 from Ruth to I64, and all other routes within 5 miles of the Charleston City Limits.
