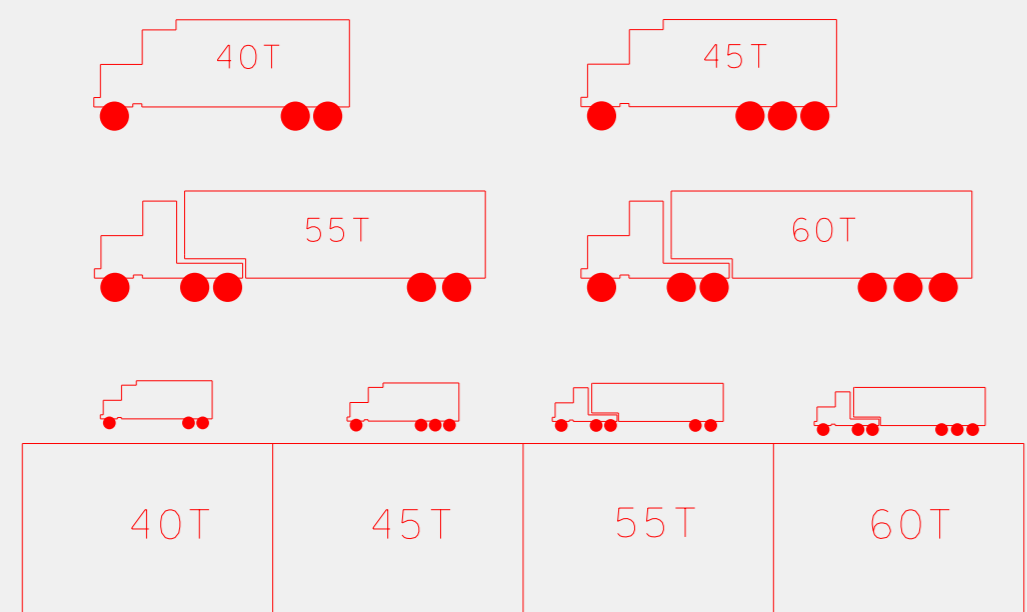
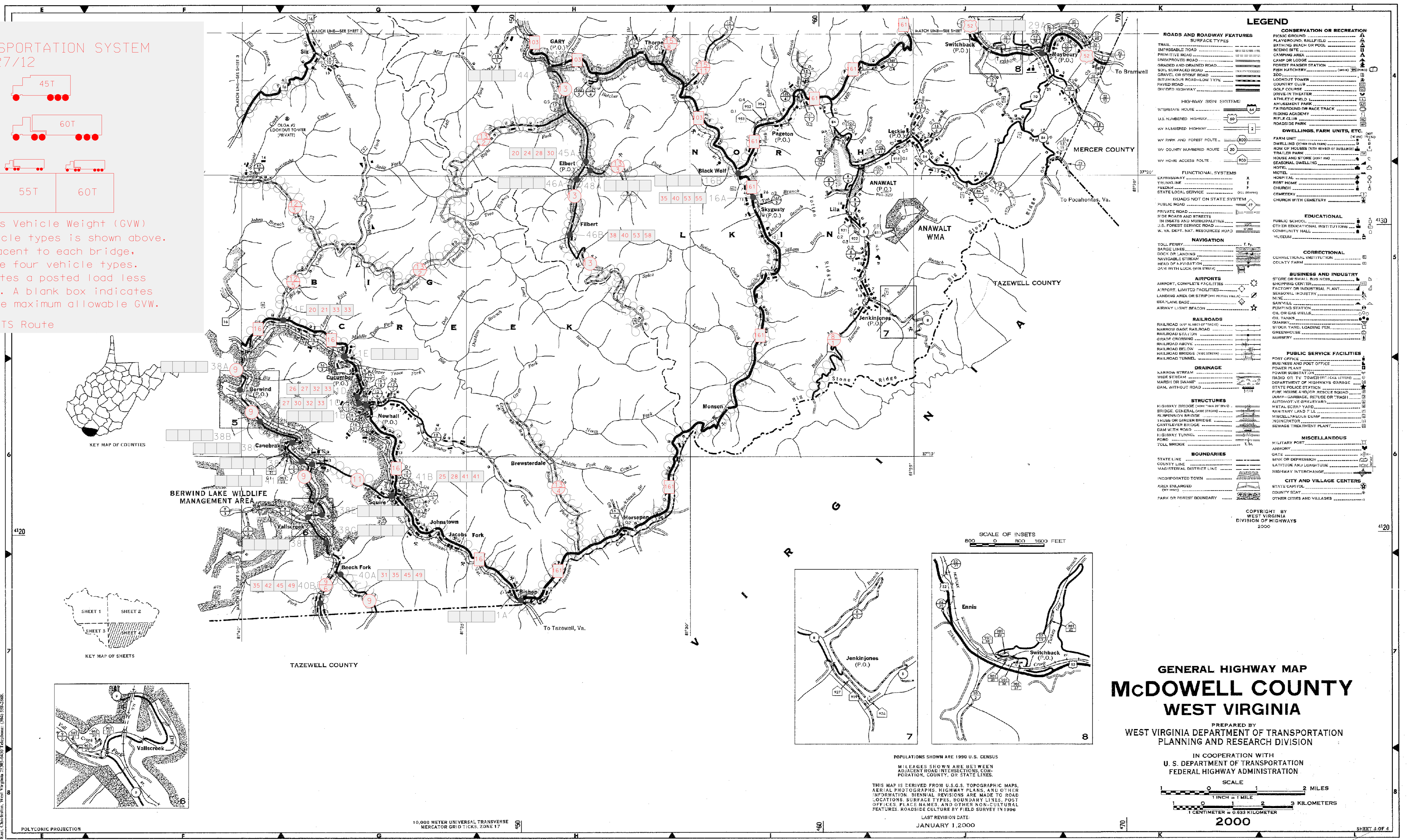


**COAL RESOURCE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM (CRTS) 7/27/12**

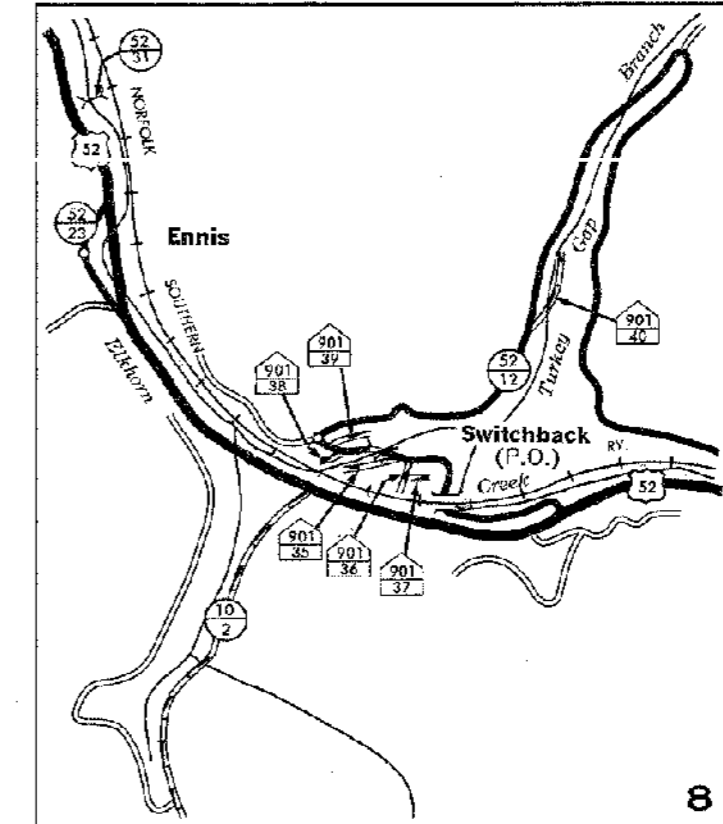
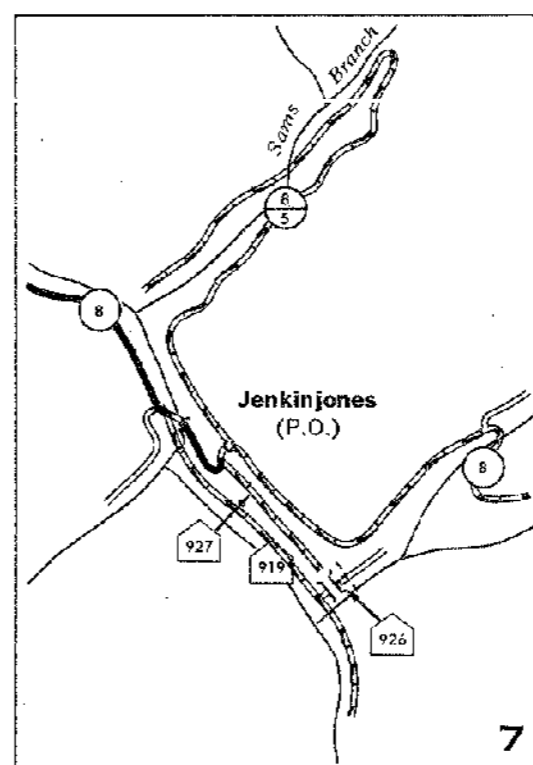
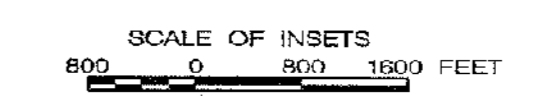
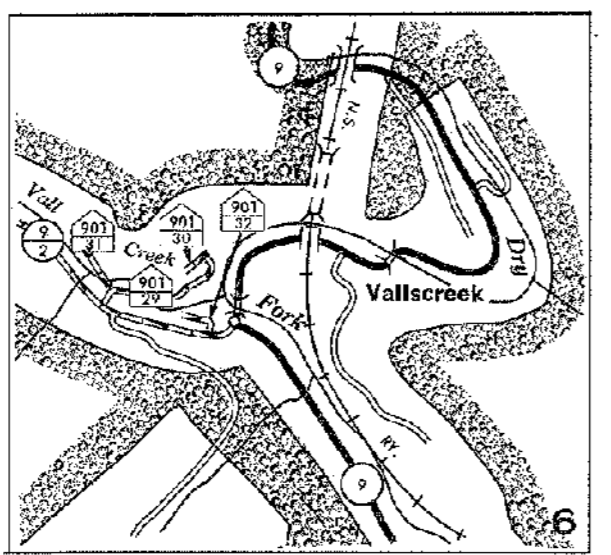
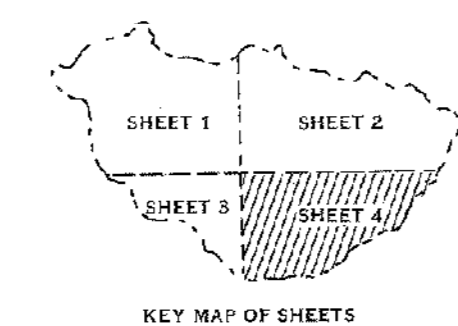
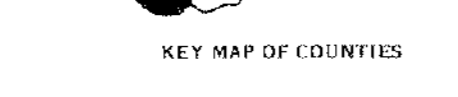
