

WV ALCOHOL & DRUG TEST AND LOCK PROGRAM REVOCATION INTERLOCK INFORMATION

West Virginia Law requires that any individuals who commit certain DUI offenses must have their driver's license revoked and must successfully complete the Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program (Interlock) before having their full driving privileges restored.

The Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program requires that an ignition Interlock and camera device be placed in all vehicles owned or used by the individual enrolled in the program. This device uses a sample of the individual's breath to determine if they have consumed any alcohol and will prevent them from starting the vehicle if the sample given results in a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of 0.025 or higher. The device also keeps a record of the following events:

- Total number of attempts made to start the vehicle
- Alcohol levels of the individual when starting or attempting to start the vehicle
- Alcohol levels at random intervals while the vehicle is running
- Any attempts made to circumvent the device
- Dates and times in which the vehicle is operated

SECTION A PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

In order to be eligible for the Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program, you must:

1. Not have any other revocations;
2. Have an active DUI revocation on your driving record;
3. Not be appealing the revocation administratively, in Circuit Court or in Supreme Court;
4. Have completed or be enrolled in the Safety and Treatment Program within 60 days after beginning the Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program;
5. Own the vehicle(s) to be used in the Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program, or have the owner's written approval for the installation of the ignition Interlock device; and
6. Be at least 18 years of age.

SECTION B PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS FOR APPROVED PARTICIPANTS

Once approved for the Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program and ignition Interlock device:

1. You will receive written notification from the WV DMV with an approval number and a list of authorized ignition Interlock device service providers from which to choose. You must contact the service provider you choose to schedule an installation appointment. You must have the ignition device installed within six (6) months of the date of application for the Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program.
2. You must be driven to the appointment for the ignition Interlock device installation.
3. Your vehicle must be manufactured after 1988 and may require an inspection to verify it is equipped with OBD I (On Board Diagnostics Generation 1) in order for the ignition Interlock and camera devices to be installed. Give the ignition Interlock service provider the make/model/year of your vehicle when making the installation appointment.
4. You will be required to return to the installation center **at least** every 30-60 days for vehicle monitoring so data can be downloaded from the device and reported to DMV.
5. You will be subject to removal from the Interlock Program for any program violations, including, but limited to:
 - Failure to report for device monitoring every 30 days, or as scheduled
 - If DMV receives notices from any law enforcement officer, DMV employee, or Interlock service provider, that indicates you operated a vehicle not equipped with an ignition Interlock device
 - Failure to abide by the service agreement with the Interlock service provider
 - If the participant, or anyone else aside from the Interlock service provider, is found tampering with, bypassing, or removing the Interlock or camera devices
 - Any obscene gestures and/or displays by the Interlock participant or anyone inside the vehicle
 - Attempting to start or operate the vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, intoxicant, or drug
 - Failure to submit to and pass any retests prompted by the ignition Interlock device after the vehicle has been started
 - Accumulation of Interlock violations in accordance with DMV policy
 - If you fail to enroll in, have no progress in, or withdraw yourself from the DUI Safety and Treatment Program
 - If anyone but the driver of the Interlock-equipped vehicle blows into the device;
 - Failure to provide a copy of your resident state's driver's license (if not WV) to WV DMV within 30 days of having the Interlock device installed
 - Failure to provide a copy of the required monthly drug test if participating with a controlled substance offense, or
 - If there is a positive result on the required monthly drug test that is not consistent with prescribed medication if participating with a controlled substance offense.

SECTION C PROGRAM LENGTH

Situation 1:

If you want to **avoid** your revocation, you **must** apply and be approved for the ignition Interlock Program before your scheduled revocation date. In this situation, the revocation period (days, months, etc.) will be **added** to the ignition Interlock device participation period. For example, if your minimum revocation period is 15 days and the ignition Interlock installation period is 4 months, the participation period would become 15 days plus 4 months.

Situation 2:

If you **do not** apply for the Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program **before** your revocation period begins, your minimum revocation period and Interlock device installation period are shown on the chart on page 2.

Applicants under 21 years of age:

If you were under age of 21 at the time you were arrested for your DUI offense and had a BAC of **less than .08**, you may be eligible for having your record cleared **after** successfully completing the Alcohol & Drug Test and Lock Program. (Some restrictions apply)

SECTION D SAFETY AND TREATMENT PROGRAM PROVIDER INFORMATION

West Virginia law prohibits the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles from reissuing a driver's license or driving privileges to anyone who is required to participate in the Safety and Treatment Program until after the offender has successfully completed the requirements of the program and has paid all associate fees. The completion of this program is a mandatory requirement for the reinstatement of your driving privileges and it cannot be waived.

The Safety and Treatment Program is only available through approved providers. The accompanying list (DMV-308-SE-2) contains approved provider locations, telephone numbers, web addresses (if applicable), as well as the counties each provider serves. Your program provider will submit all required documents to the DMV on your behalf. Please allow at least 20 business days for the processing of your paperwork.

If you reside outside of West Virginia, you should contact the WV DMV Safety and Treatment Unit for authorization to enroll in an approved out-of-state alcohol/drug education program. You may contact the Safety and Treatment Unit by calling 1-877-215-2522, emailing wvdui@wv.gov, or by visiting online at dmv.wv.gov/drivers/safety_and_treatment.

ENROLLING IN THE SAFETY AND TREATMENT PROGRAM

NOTICE: All Approved Safety and Treatment Program Providers are Listed on Document DMV-308-SE-2.

- DO NOT** go to any program provider location without an appointment. You **must** call the program provider to make an appointment first. The provider will need the file number listed on your revocation letter to complete the enrollment process. Please have this number available upon request.
- If it is determined through your individual assessment and evaluation that alcohol and/or drugs are, or have, the potential for creating problems for you, additional treatment may be required. The extent of your treatment will be determined upon completion of your assessment by the program provider.
- You **must** comply with all recommendations made by your program provider in order to be successful in completing the Safety and Treatment Program.
