**NOTICE OF AN OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC MEETING AND COMMENT ON THE
PROPOSED PARTIAL ABANDONMENT OF COUNTY ROUTE 20 (0.28 MILE) LOCATED IN
MARION COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA**

The West Virginia Division of Highways hereby provides notice of the proposed partial abandonment of County Route 20, beginning at a point on CR 20, said point being 1.62 miles northwest of the northern junction of CR 20 and WV 218; thence northerly for 0.28 mile and ending, as located in Marion County, West Virginia. Total length to be abandoned is 0.28 mile.

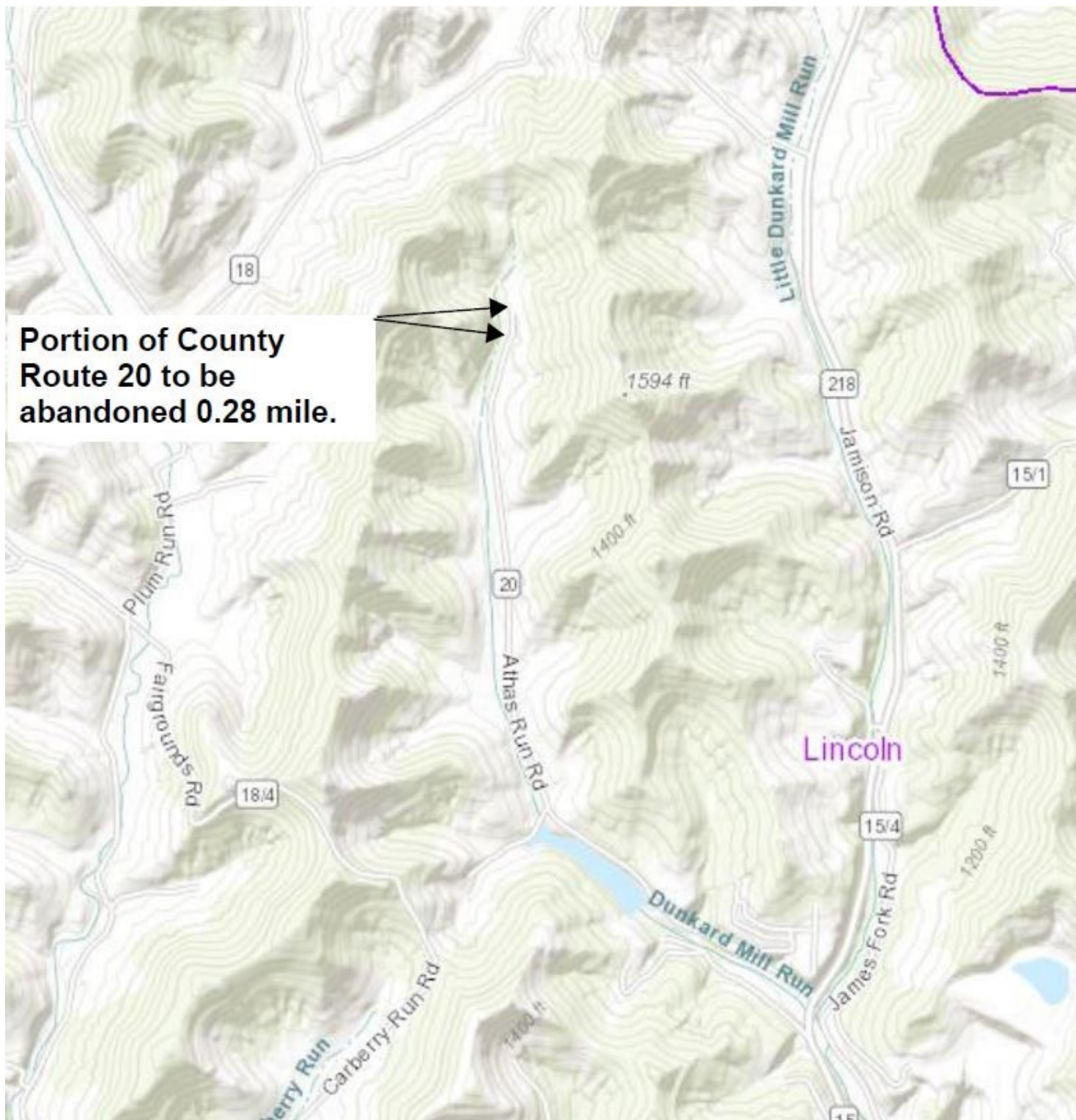
The District is requesting the abandonment on behalf of the only affected property owners, Joe Potoczny and Bonnie Potoczny.
