







INFORMATIONAL VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING HANDOUT HARPERS FERRY HIGH STREET STATE PROJECT U319-HAR/PE-2.00 FEDERAL PROJECT TAP-2017(082)DTC DECEMBER 15, 2020

The West Virginia Division of Highways (WVDOH) will hold a virtual public meeting December 15, 2020 for the proposed project on High Street to improve pedestrian and vehicular safety extending from Hog Alley to approximately 300 feet east of Church Street. A formal recorded presentation will be made at 4PM, 5PM, and 6PM. The public will be afforded the opportunity to ask questions and give written comments on the project after each presentation.

This is a preliminary workshop through which the WVDOH officials will present information and seek public input regarding the design study and to improve High Street. Three alternatives were developed: (1) generally leave the existing sidewalk and roadway conditions unchanged, and evaluate features such as the retaining walls, railings, and downspouts; (2) the closure of one lane of traffic permanently between Hog Alley and Public Way; and (3) the shifting of roadway alignment between Hog Alley and Public Way two feet to the south and widen the existing sidewalk equivalently.
