



# Legislative Process (House and Senate)

- Draft Bill
- 2. Introduce Bill
- 3. Committee Action (hearings, markups and reports)
- 4. Floor Action (debate, amendments, votes)
- 5. Conference (to resolve differences b/w H & S bills)
- 6. Vote/Passage
- 7. President Signs
- 8. Law Printed, Codified





# Timeline of Last Reauthorization

- June, 2002: began drafting legislative language
- February, 2003: to OMB for interagency clearance
- April, 2003: second submission to OMB for interagency clearance
- May, 2003: OMB cleared bill and the Secretary transmitted the bill to the Hill.
- September, 2003: No reauthorization fill in place extension required.
- August, 2005: after 12 extensions, SAFETEA-LU was signed into law.



## **Reauthorization Status**

  - SAFETEA-LU expires on September 30, 2009
  - Highway Trust Fund Balance
