Safety

Hatfield-McCoy Trails Strictly Enforces All Manufacturer's Safety Guidelines, Such As:

- D.O.T./Snell approved helmet is required
- "Doubling" is prohibited unless approved by the manufacturer
- Protective Eyewear is required
- Riders must wear over the ankle footwear
- All vehicles must be equipped with a spark arrestor





Hatfield-McCoy Sets the Standard in Safety

- Strict safety rules set forth by the Authority and Enforcement by State Police certified Rangers.
- The Trails have received National Recognition for ATV Safety from the National Off Highway Vehicle Conservation Council




Percentage of Days Spent in Hatfield-McCoy Country




Amount Visitors Spend Per Trip






Participants Rate the Experience





Riders Likelihood to Return




