Reduces drag by 65%






Each shares the hardest role and flies up front

Proposed Budget

- \$302 Billion over 4 years reauthorization proposal
 - Combines highways and transit
- \$ 199 Billion for Highways and road safety
 - 5 Billion over 4 years for TIGER
 - 13. 4 Billion In the Fix-IT-First Initiative
 - Prioritized towards highways and bridges most in need of repair
 - Patterned after the Dept. of Education's "Race to the Top" initiative




