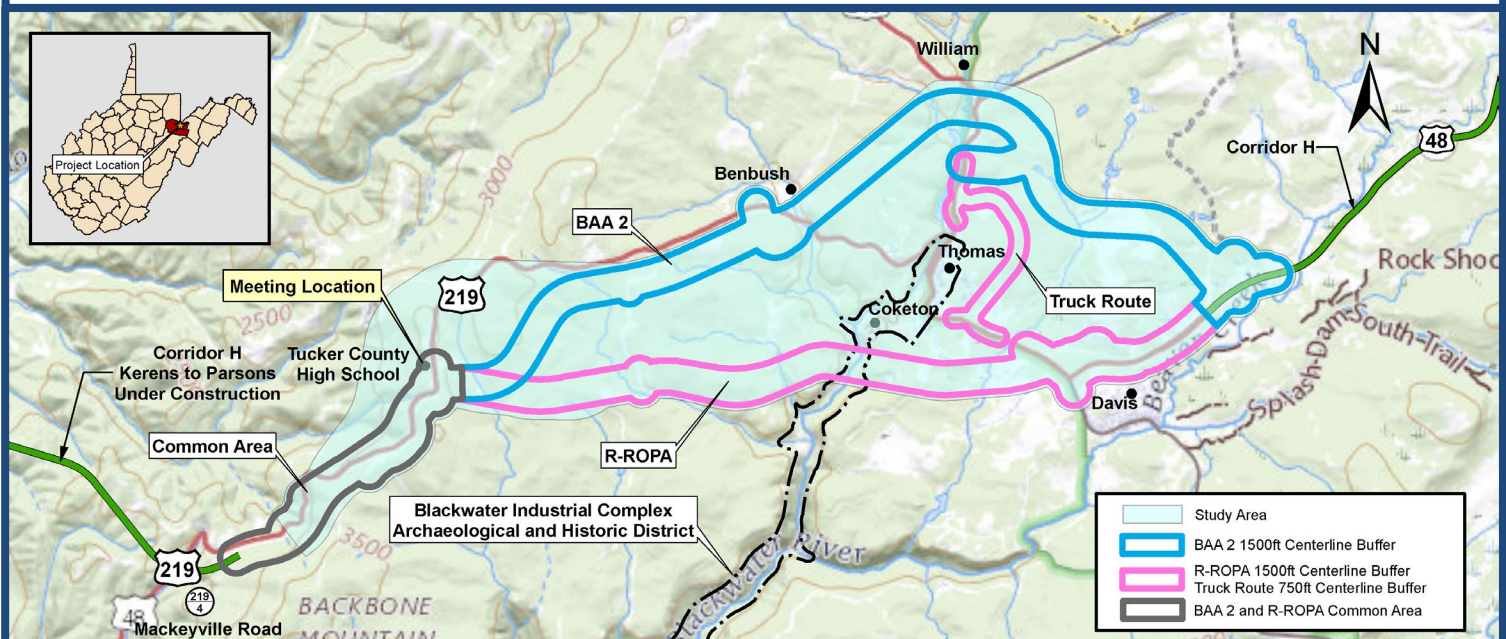
CORRIDOR H – PARSONS TO DAVIS PROJECT

The West Virginia Division of Highways (WVDOH) and United States Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has issued a Notice of Intent (NOI) to prepare a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) for the Parsons to Davis Project. An Informational Public Meeting/Workshop will be held at the Tucker County High School in Hambleton, WV. NO FORMAL PRESENTATION WILL BE MADE.

Representatives from the WVDOH and FHWA will be available from 4:00 to 7:00 pm to provide updates on the project and answer questions. Project maps and other materials will be available to review. *Upon request, WVDOH will provide reasonable accommodations to afford an individual with a disability an equal opportunity to participate. The Parsons to Davis Project is an approximately 9-mile, new location, four-lane, divided highway, with partial control of access. The Project begins east of Parsons, 0.2 mile north of the intersection of Tucker County Route 219/4 (Mackeyville Road) and United States Route 219, which is also the eastern terminus of the Kerens to Parsons Project. The Project ends north of Davis along WV State Route (WV) 93, 1.3 miles east of WV 32, which is also the western terminus of the Davis to Bismarck Project.
