

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

- Q1: Section 3.1.1.6 states that vendor will provide 2 years of support after initial commissioning. That is a very open-ended request and I ask that we put a maximum allowable time (hours) restriction on this? Also, is the support just by telephone or email rather than traveling to job site?
 - A1: The tech support is for two years and includes whatever is needed including email, phone, onsite or software modifications.
- Q2: Section 3.1.1.7 states that we need to provide modified electrical prints? Does this mean that you will supply current and updated electrical drawings for the GP38 and we will just need to add the new system onto those? And will they be available electronically in Autocad or something like that or will we need to come up with an all new version? Are they paper or electronic? Are we expected to update with incorporation of new control system? The standard is to provide a copy of schematic of the stand-alone system only?
 - A2: New complete electrical prints are to be provided by the vendor. These prints must be a complete schematic of the locomotive as wired with the traction control system installed. A set of schematics (paper) will be provided to the vendor as reference but must be returned to the SBVR.
- Q3: What level of electrical experience does the installation team have on installing microprocessors on locomotives?
 - A3: We have a certified electrician on staff. The shop can handle the installation as long as the instructions are understandable and indicate what to install and what to remove/modify.
- Q4: Can we ask for an advanced milestone payment to cover engineering and software development .
 - A4: No advanced payment will be made. 100% payment is sent when goods are delivered to customer satisfaction.
- Q5: What is the capability of track testing on site? Meaning do we have track available for testing and commissioning to test the system.
 - A5: Yes there is track available for testing
