

2020 HIGH TRAVEL DAYS, EVENTS AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS
WHERE TRAVEL IS NOT ALLOWED

| Independence Day | Saturday, July 4, 2020 |
| Labor Day | Saturday September 5, 2020 through Monday, September 7, 2020 |
| Thanksgiving Day | Thursday, November 26, 2020 |
| Christmas Day | Friday, December 25, 2020 |
| New Year's Day | Friday, January 1, 2021 |

Oversize loads are not allowed to travel from sunset to sunrise.

Event Restrictions – No Over dimensional travel between sunrise of the first date until sunset of the last date.

West Virginia University football games – No travel in Monongalia, Marion, Harrison and Preston Counties on the day of home games.

Pioneer Days Festival – No travel in Marlinton (Pocahontas County) on July 9 –11, 2020 **

State Fair – No travel on US219 from I64 to Ronceverte (Greenbrier County) on August 13 – 22, 2020

Treasure Mountain Festival – No travel in Franklin (Pendleton County) on September 17 - 20, 2020 **

Forest Festival – No travel in Elkins (Randolph County) on September 26 - October 4, 2020 **

Bridge Day – No travel on US 19 between US 60 and Oak Hill (Fayette County) on October 17, 2020

Other Restrictions

School Bus Hours – No travel allowed Monday through Friday on two lane highways for escorted vehicles from 7 AM to 9 AM and 2:30 PM to 4:00 PM from August 10, 2019 through June 7, 2020.

Charleston Area – No travel allowed for escorted vehicles from 7 AM to 9 AM and 4 PM to 6 PM during daylight savings time.

During Eastern Standard Time, travel is allowed only from 9 AM to 4 PM. Charleston area includes I64 between Exit 39 and Exit 85, I77 between Exit 106 and Exit 85, US119 from Ruth to I64, and all other routes within 5 miles of the Charleston City Limits.
