Old Business:

- 1. MP 717.04.21: Guide for Quality Control of Compaction VOTED & PASSED
- Added requirement of contractor's QC plan stating names of individuals entering data
 - If a consultant enters data, is the individual's name or the company listed?
 - Do best to amend it/both
- MP discussed in detail at previous meeting

0. MP 109.00.21: Basis For Charges for NonSubmittal of Sampling & Testing Documentation by The Established Deadline TABLED UNTIL NEXT MEETING

- Currently the industry has minimal training for AWP. Could materials refrain from approving provision until addressed?
 - Upper management has said to approve by committee,
 - Per following the chain of approval after committee, this will not be effective immediately
 - There is a training guide and there are/ will become available sessions
 - This will continue moving forward but slowly
 - Any commitment from DOH to hold off until around next year?
 - Want year of trial and error of entering their information in since learning new software
- Further discussion/ review required

0. MP 106.10.50: WVDOH Buy America Acceptance Guidelines **VOTED & PASSED**

- Document does not show all track changes
- Significant changes made based off FHWA guidance
 - Definitions were changed to go into further detail
- On the practical side, it demonstrates what materials require BA certificate and what do not

- Section 8.2.2: created a report in AWP that will give list of materials that are Buy America required
 - Will need updating because current changes
 - On AWP, your project will run report it for you
 - Contract submits certificate of compliance containing multiple material
- Editorial Changes
 - incorporated changed to permanently incorporated
- Temporary items do not require Buy America as of now

0. MP 106.10.51: WVDOH Buy America Waiver Guidelines TABLED UNTIL NEXT MEETING

- Still requires another working session
- When would the waiver request happen?
 - Criteria must be met goes through state goes through Federal Highways goes through headquarters
 - Must start early because process can take up to 3 years
 - Meant to be conducted in development phase
 - FHWA website lists current and past waivers

0. MP 711.03.23: Mix Design for Portland Cement Concrete **VOTED & PASSED**

- Removing requirement for 6x12 and only specifying for 4x8
- Incorporating reference document sections
- Editorial Changes: Instead of source it is producer supplier

New Business:

- 1. MP 106.03.50: General Information Guide for Technician and Inspector Certification Program (TICP)
- Remove implementation committee and maintain board
 - Committee was not being used
 - Is there a room for producers and contractors on the board?
 - Possibly do not want producers and/or contractor voting on certain things
 - Reviewing and up for consideration
- Changes human resources director to deputy general counsel
- Use to have handbook, getting rid of that and putting directly into material procedure
- Editorial changes: spelling, word repetition
- Section 13.2: #5 What does trial mix mixture refer to?
 - Under review, possible wording from old mp
- In the appeal process, the letter will have information on how to respond?
 - Assumed to send the letter back to the person who sent the letter, information should be included in letter

0. MP 106.00.02: Procedure for Evaluating Products for Use in Highway Construction

- Give producer supplier ability to get approved for purchase order, process for reviewing and approving materials outside standard bid contract order
- Section 5.3 saying anyone can make up specification, the language is vague
- What if we don't have the ability to test different materials? Are we buying new equipment
- Before, data was submitted from independent lab to get approved but trying to get away from having products used without being tested
