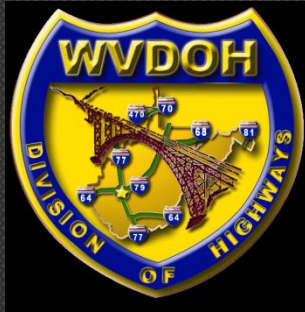

Responsibilities of the Programming Division

- Execution of the Highway Program
 - Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program
- 6 Year Federal Highways Administration Document
 - First 4 Years Required and Next 2 Years for Information
- All Federal Aid Projects must be Approved and on the Federal STIP
 - Amendment and Adjustments Done Regularly



Responsibilities of the Programming Division

- Execution of the Highway Program
 - Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program
- Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)
 - Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP)
 - Projects First Approved in TIP then in STIP

Responsibilities of the Programming Division

- Execution of the Highway Program
 - State Statewide Transportation Improvement Program
 - Same Time Frame as Federal STIP
 - Discretionary Projects from the Program Review Committee



Responsibilities of the Programming Division

- Monitor the Health of the Highway Program
 - Projects Under Construction Report
 - TRIP Report
 - Federal and State STIP Updates
 - Budgets and Associated Established Allocation Limits

 - Surface Transportation Program
 - National Highway Performance Program

State Projects

- Project Types
 - Resurfacing
 - Slips/Slides
 - Bridge Repairs and Replacements

State Projects

- Project Types
 - Guardrail
 - Renovation
 - Industrial Development

State Projects

- Allocations
 - A - Resurfacing, Surface Treatment, Stone Stabilization
 - B – Renovation (Skip Patching, Guardrail, Structures > 20')
 - C – Bridge

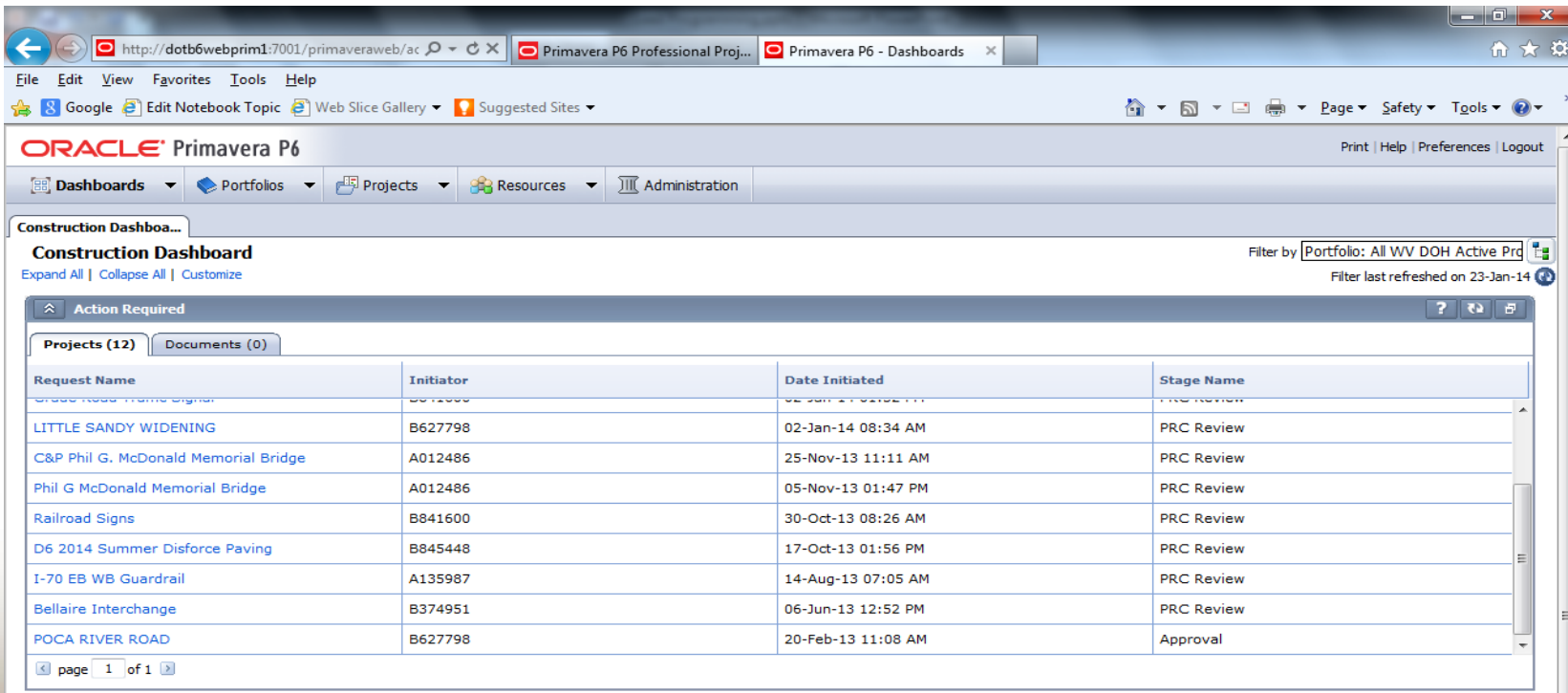
